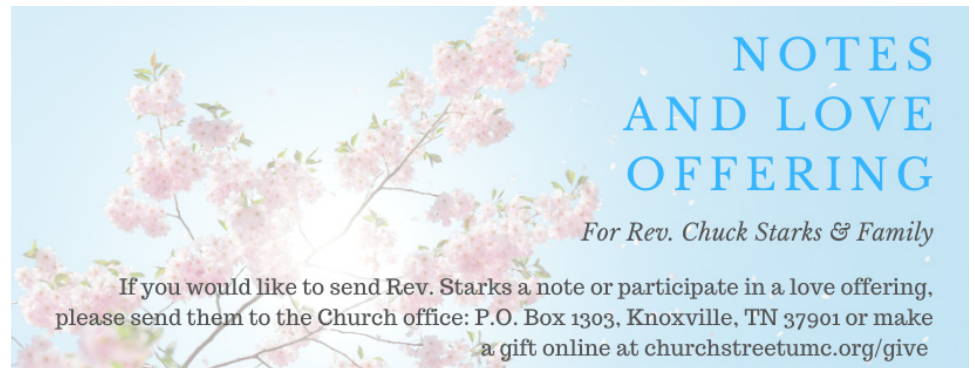

Don't Forget: Church Street Check-In! Respond by May 30

Thanks to those who have already completed this survey! Sent by email and in the print version of last week's *Messenger*, this check-in includes questions about your life during the pandemic, how you feel about Church Street's re-gathering for in-person worship, what type of engagement you seek through Church Street during Covid-19, and more. We hope you'll take some time to answer these questions honestly, as it will help our clergy, staff, Parish Health Ministry, and SASH teams continue to finalize a plan for re-opening when the time comes. The survey should take between 5-10 minutes to complete.

On May 26, Church Council endorsed an operation plan crafted by Parish Health Ministry, SASH leaders, and CSUMC staff members, for a phased approach to re-gathering in person for worship. As information is shared by the Holston Conference leadership about re-opening plans, we will update and share Church Street's guidelines for re-gathering in person through multiple channels of communication. The bishop has announced that she hopes to share a plan by June 1.
