We will gather in the Parish Hall at 11 a.m.

Dr. Freeland is a longtime Church Streeter, a member of the Lydia Circle, and Professor of Political Science at UT. As Chair of the Women's Studies, she serves on committees struggling to deal with the complex issue of campus sexual assault.
