## Service of Healing And Forgiveness Sunday, January 22, 5:45 - 6:30 p.m. - Chapel

*Are any among you sick? They should call for the elders of the church and have them pray over them, anointing them with oil in the name of the Lord... Therefore confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another, so that you may be healed. The prayer of the righteous is powerful and effective (5:14,16).*

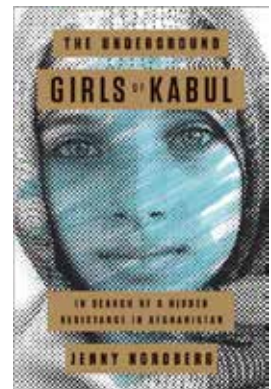
## Lenten Devotions Needed

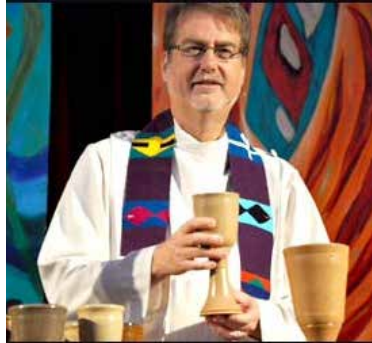
