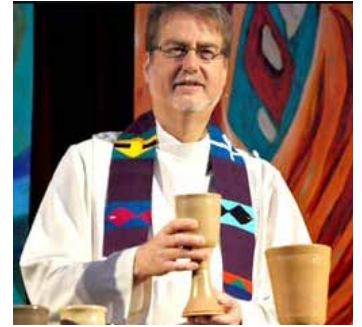
Building for Christ Update

In the new addition, the four stained glass tower windows, currently located in the church tower, will be moved to flank the entry from the new Commons area into the Parish Hall. This will allow our church history to be more accessible and the windows to be enjoyed by many in the congregation. The Christian Home window, currently located on the north wall of the 1931 building, will need to be relocated as a result of the new addition. It will be carefully moved to flank the stairway connecting the new Commons Area with the Nave. Below is a drawing that shows the placement of the relocated tower windows.
