She formerly served as the Holston Conference Children's Ministry Coordinator. Anita will share a new hope-filled message about the program participants, despite the immense challenges of operating in the recently violent atmosphere of South Sudan. In 2008, Africa ELI opened a school for girls with financial support from grassroots donors with a World Bank two-year grant. For reasons based on culture, economics, health, and limitations in basic services such as access to water and

transport, girls are less likely to enroll in school and more likely to drop out early.
