- **9 am - 10 am in the Gym: Food Buckets for Zimbabwe** - Help pack our annual hands-on missions project! These food buckets will go to our ministry partner, the Ishe Anesu Project in Zimbabwe.
- **10 am - 12 pm in Parish Hall: Food packing for local ministries** - Our goal is to pack 20,000 meals in 2 hours to help ministries in our local community!
- **1 pm - 2 pm in the Gym: UMCOR Kits** - Help assemble cleaning and hygiene

kits to support the ministries of the United Methodist Committee on Relief.

- **HALF DAY OPPORTUNITY! 9:30 am - 2:30 pm at Wesley Foundation on UTK Campus: Wesley House Building Improvements (age 16+)** - The Wesley Foundation is the UM college ministry on the UTK campus. Projects include painting and yard work. Supplies provided!
